# Het Noordbrabants Museum

**With resplendent exhibitions and varied programmes, Het Noordbrabants Museum showcases the wealth of Brabant's art, history and culture. From Hieronymus Bosch to Dutch Design, and from Vincent van Gogh to an original vintage DAF daffodil.**

Het Noordbrabants Museum is housed in an eighteenth century government palace in the heart of 's-Hertogenbosch, a beautiful medieval city in Brabant. The collection of old art gratifies visitors with landscapes, allegorical images and portraits by Pieter Brueghel. The contemporary art collection includes works by Jan Sluijters, Piet Mondrian and Marc Mulders. Together with the Stedelijk Museum 's-Hertogenbosch, Het Noordbrabants Museum is one of the largest cultural attractions in the Netherlands. In 2018 the programme will include exhibitions about Dr. Uli Sigg's Chinese art collection, breakthrough artist Manish Nai, modernist artist Jan Sluijters, and the first part of the exhibition series *Dichter bij Bosch* (Closer to Bosch).

## Close to Van Gogh

Van Gogh is one of Brabant's greatest sons; his work still echoes with the memories of Brabant where he was born and the people he met there. For that reason, Van Gogh deserves a spot in the permanent exhibition and in the exhibition programming. Het Noordbrabants Museum is the only museum in the south of the Netherlands which has ten of Vincent van Gogh's works from his Brabant period. The museum also has a central role when it comes to bringing together Van Gogh's art, his history and cultural heritage sites around the province. The cultural heritage foundations that are part of Van Gogh Brabant will also play a part in the exhibition *Van Gogh's Intimate Circle*.

## Van Gogh's intimate circle

21 September 2019 to 12 January 2020

This exhibition will give a broad view on the people who played an important part in Van Gogh's life and work. His complex relationships with family, friends and fellow artists, students and models from Brabant to the south of France were often strong and long-lasting, but sometimes ended in estrangement. The exhibition includes prominent pieces from the Netherlands and abroad, some of which have never been seen in this country before and never together in one exhibition. The exhibition combines portraits that Van Gogh made of his friends and fellow artists, such as Gauguin and Signac, with works by those same artists but also with drawings, letters, pictures and poetry. A surprising new perspective on one of the world's greatest artists.
